

# Carr Creek State Park

Enjoy the shores of Carr Creek Lake, once home to some of the area's earliest pioneer settlements as early as the 1770s. Carr Fork, a tributary of the North Fork of the Kentucky River, is located 8.8 miles below Carr Creek Dam, and is thought to have gotten its name from William Carr, a well-known "Long Hunter" who hunted in the area. Modern-day visitors to the park can relax amid a chorus of nature in the campground or frolic under the sun at the public beach surrounded by the mountains of southeastern Kentucky. The marsh environment in the Carr Creek area is unusual for the mountains of Eastern Kentucky, but provides a wide assortment of watchable wildlife.

**CAMPING AND RV:** 39-site campground, all with water and electric hook-ups. Reservations on-line or at 1-844-459-7275.

**FISHING:** 710-acre lake for pleasure boaters and anglers, with miles of shoreline, offers good bass, crappie and walleye fishing.

**MARINA:** Full-service marina with snack bar located near the park. Pontoon and fishing boat rentals. Open year-round. 606-642-3239.

**PUBLIC BEACH:** Longest sand beach in the Kentucky State Park system. Open for the summer season.

**PICNICKING:** Picnic facilities available.
