All our ingredients are of the highest quality and as a supporter of the Kentucky Proud program, we use locally grown meats and produce when available.




Greenbo Lake State Resort Park

Grayson Lake State Park, with an outstanding golf course and marina, is located 28 miles southeast of Carter Caves.

Greenbo Lake State Resort Park, offering boating, fishing and an outdoor amphitheatre, is located 35 miles northeast of Carter Caves.

Yatesville Lake State Park, in Louisa, is one hour Southeast of Carter Caves, offers golfing, camping, fishing, and a public beach.



CAVE TOURS

- Cascade Cave features a waterfall
 - X Cave is named for its passages
 - Saltpetre Cave (seasonal) is tied to early Kentucky history
 - Bat Cave (temporarily closed due to WNS), the largest, is the winter home to thousands of rare bats
 - Cave tour schedules vary by season
