Stone Crest Golf Course, an 18-hole championship golf course, overlooks Jenny Wiley State Resort Park.



ELK WATCHING

Elk were reintroduced to Kentucky in 1997 as a restoration project by the Kentucky Department of Fish & Wildlife. From 1997 - 2003 approximately 1513 elk were transported into Kentucky. Reproduction has been very high, with approximately 90% of the adult cows producing calves. Currently, the estimated elk population in Kentucky is over 12,000. The best areas for elk habitat are on reclaimed surface mines in Eastern Kentucky.

The largest elk herds are located on privately-owned lands normally closed to the public, but through agreements between Kentucky State Parks and land owners, you have the opportunity to see the largest herds, accompanied by a knowledgeable guide.

Jenny Wiley State Resort Park is sponsoring elk tours to guests which includes transportation via van to the viewing sites and continental breakfast. We also offer packages that include lodging. Pre-registration is recommended, as tours do fill up quickly. Group and business tours also available.
