**Cumberland Falls State Resort Park**, the only place in the Western Hemisphere to view a moonbow, is located less than 60 miles northwest of Pine Mountain.


**Cumberland Gap National Historical Park**, the first great gateway to the west, is just 12 miles south. Trails and scenic features.

### HERNDON J. EVANS LODGE

Pine Mountain is not only one of Kentucky's most scenic parks, but also a very modern resort with a hint of a historic past.

The upper lobby of the Herndon J. Evans Lodge was built in the 1930's by the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC). The passage of time has not diminished the beauty and workmanship of the original sandstone and chestnut log construction.

Each of the 30 guest rooms features full amenities and a private balcony from which to enjoy the mountain view. Pet-friendly rooms are now available. Gift selections in the lobby highlight Kentucky artisans and handcrafts.

Pine Mountain State Resort Park is a destination for all seasons. It's located in the heart of the Kentucky Ridge State Forest in the southeastern mountains and features beautiful mountain scenery!

### MOUNTAIN VIEW RESTAURANT

## WASIOTO WINDS GOLF COURSE

Wasioto Winds was rated fourth among Best New Affordable Public Golf Courses in January 2003 issue of Golf Digest. The \$10 million Michael Hurdzan-designed golf course is "a difficult course but friendly to the high handicapper." This 18-hole course includes five par 3 holes and five par 5s. True to its links nature, the course is relatively flat, with water coming into play from three lakes, a creek and several wetlands areas. Six arching bridges span the water throughout the course. Other course features include wide cart paths, practice range, two practice putting greens, and an indoor training center.
