

#### Interesting places to visit:

Carr Creek State Park – 35 miles N via US119 to Whitesburg & Ky15, camping, fishing & swimming.

Pine Mountain State Resort Park – 55 miles SW at Pineville, lodge with restaurant, cottages, pool, miniature golf, trails, 18-hole golf course, and scenic mountain views.

Bad Branch Falls State Nature Preserve – 20 miles E via US119 then KY932, hiking.



# TENT CAMPING • PICNIC • HIKING • WILDLIFE WATCHING



With an elevation of 2,700 feet, Kingdom Come is Kentucky's highest state park. On the crest of Pine Mountain, the park offers scenic vistas second to none. The park also provides access to the Little Shepherd Trail, a 38-mile scenic drive currently serving as a section of the Pine Mountain State Scenic Trail. Once completed this backpacking trail will be 120 miles long. Currently, about 82 miles is open for backpacking.

## *Camping*

Limited primitive tent camping in designated area. No camping on park trails. Call park for information.

## *Recreational Activities*

Miniature golf and rental pedal boats (seasonal), playgrounds, basketball goal, horseshoes and volleyball.

## *Fishing*

The 3.5-acre lake holds largemouth bass, bluegill, crappie, catfish and trout.

## *Gift Shop*

Features Kentucky crafts, souvenirs, and interpretive panels on local wildlife, folklore, and geology - seasonal.

## *Special Events*

- Kentucky Black Bear Festival (May)

## *Hiking Trails*

14 hiking trails that crisscross nearly 5 miles of rugged mountain terrain. Extraordinary rock formations are featured, including Log Rock, a natural sandstone bridge, and Raven Rock, a giant monolith that soars 290-feet into the air at a 45-degree angle.

## *Little Shepherd Trail*

Narrow gravel and blacktop road extends 38 miles along the crest of Pine Mountain, providing a scenic route.

## *Picnicking*

2 picnic shelters with grills, and restrooms. Picnic areas and stone fireplace grills throughout the park.

## *Cave Amphitheater*

Equipped with lighting and seating to accommodate groups seeking a totally natural meeting site.

## *Nature Preserve*

This 225-acre preserve protects Kentucky's third-largest colony of the federally endangered Indiana bat. Visit [www.naturepreserves.ky.gov](http://www.naturepreserves.ky.gov) to read more about the mission and regulations of this and other nature preserve areas.
