# Lincoln Homestead State Park



Perryville Battlefield State Historic Site

## Interesting places to visit:

Perryville Battlefield State Historic Site – 18 miles east via Hwy 150, has battlefield, picnic area, self-guided trails, & museum.

Constitution Square State Historic Site – 26 miles east via Hwy 150, has replica and original cabins depicting life in the late 1700's & early 1800's, picnic tables, and governors' memorial..

Old Fort Harrod State Park – 27 miles northeast via Hwy 150 and Hwy 68, has fort depicting first permanent settlement west of the Alleghenies. Rental facilities, picnic areas, museum and gift shop.

Five miles north of Springfield. Take the Bluegrass Parkway to US 150 east or KY 555 south. From US 150 east, take KY 555 north to KY 528 west to KY 438. From KY 555 south take KY 438 west to the park.

Lincoln Homestead State Park features the original home of Abraham Lincoln's mother, Nancy Hanks, as well as replicas of the 1782 cabin where his father Thomas lived as a child, and a blacksmith shop. The grounds are surrounded by split-rail fences, and the cabins have a collection of pioneer furniture. Also at the Park, and located on its original site, is the home of Mordecai Lincoln, uncle of the President.

### *Lincoln Cabin*

The Lincoln cabin is a replica that rests on the site of the original log house in which the President's grandmother, Bersheba, raised her five children. Thomas Lincoln, father of the President, lived here until he was 25 years of age.

### *Berry House*

Nancy Hanks, mother of the President, lived in this original house while she was courted by Thomas Lincoln.

### *Mordecai Lincoln House*

The home of Mordecai Lincoln, eldest son of Captain Abraham and Bersheba Lincoln, and uncle of President Lincoln is located on its original site. The house is located across from the Park's golf course. Available for meeting and event rental.

### *Golf*

Our 18-hole regulation course takes advantage of the natural rolling hills of central Kentucky. With four tee locations, golfers of all levels can find the right course to challenge their game. We feature Bermuda grass fairways and bent grass greens. There are beautiful lakes and incredible vistas throughout the golf course.

### *Picnicking & Playground*

A picnic shelter, tables, grills, rest rooms, playground and parking area are near the cabins. Shelter available for rental. May be reserved up to one year in advance.

### *Gift Shop*

The gift shop, located in the cluster of historic cabins, features Kentucky handcrafts and souvenirs.
