GET STARTED ON YOUR KENTUCKY STATE PARKS GEOTOUR

Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location.

TO PARTICIPATE IN THE KENTUCKY STATE PARKS GEOTOUR

1. Pick up a Kentucky State Parks GeoTour brochure from any Kentucky State Park or download your passport from our webpage: parks.ky.gov/geocaching.

2. Visit geocaching.com, create a username and log in. Find the GPS coordinates and more information for the Kentucky State Parks GeoTour locations.

3. Start your search and locate one or all caches using a hand-held GPS unit. The cache containers are waterproof ammo boxes labeled, as "Official KY State Parks Geocache". Caches are located in all 49 Kentucky State Parks and will remain active through Sept. 27, 2016.

4. When you locate a Kentucky State Parks GeoTour cache, log your username and comments on the logbook found in the cache. Be sure to stamp your passport with the stamp for that park and leave the logbook and stamp for the next person.

5. Always practice the principles of Leave No Trace (LNT). For more information visit parks.ky.gov/LNT

6. A limited number of custom KY State Parks Geocoins have been designed for this geotour. Mail your completed passport, along with name, username, and mailing address to:
