- (8) The undersigned certifies, accepts, and will comply with the following conditions:
- (i) **I will comply with FAA Rule 101 or Rule 107 for flight operations.**
 - (ii) **I will NOT fly over people.**
 - (iii) **I will use FAA's B4UFLY app prior to flight and will comply with any restrictions on flight.**
 - (iv) **I understand that flight over land or water owned by the United States Army Corps of Engineers or the Tennessee Valley Authority (which includes some state parks) requires the approval of the USACE or TVA.**
 - (v) **Utmost care will be exercised to see that no natural, historical or cultural features are injured, and after completion of the work the area will, as**

required by the official in charge, either be cleaned up and restored to its prior condition or left after clean-up, in a condition satisfactory to the official in charge.

- (vi) The operator of the UAV is responsible for all state, local, and federal permitting requirements.**
 - (vii) No persons, including park visitors and staff, may be filmed without their written permission.**
 - (viii) Photographing or filming of resident wildlife and/or livestock will be permitted only when such animals will not be molested, harmed, or disturbed.**
 - (ix) Any special instructions received from the official in charge of the area will be complied with.**
- (9) The applicant shall comply with the regulations and policies of the Kentucky Department of Parks and all Federal, State, county, and municipal laws, ordinances, or regulations which are applicable to the area of operations covered by this permit.
- (10) This permit is a revocable permit and may be revoked at the discretion of the Kentucky Department of Parks, or an agency designee upon 24 hours notice, or without notice if injury to person or damage to resources or facilities is threatened.
- (11) The applicant hereby agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet, the Kentucky Department of Parks, its agents, officers, and employees, from any and all claims, damages, suits at law or equity of whatever kind of nature for damages to or loss of property or injury or death to persons, including applicant and/or its agent or employee, resulting directly or indirectly from or attributable to the applicant or its agent or employees in connection with the flying activities authorized by this permit.
- (12) The applicant agrees to obtain general and/or public liability insurance insuring against injury or death to any person or persons, or damage to any property, with liability limits of no less than \$1,000,000.00, insuring against all liability of applicant, its agents, vendors and employees arising out of and in connection with applicant's use of Park premises.

Submission of this form does NOT authorize the applicant to fly a UAV until executed by the Park Manger and Commissioner of Parks (or designee).
